<p>Rules for Enlistment of Contractors in CPWD, 2021</p> <p>Shortcomings:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The upper limit for Class I (Super) has not been changed to “Unlimited” as being done on MES, State PWDs etc.2. The tendering limit should be revised by at least 15% for all Classes.3. In Clause 6.2, revision to 10% from 7% in the value of works executed during the last 7 years.4. Net Worth should be adjusted in line with the changed annual turnover.5. Completed works with Time Over Run (TOR) more than 1 should also be considered as was done in Enlistment Rules 2020. <p>The process of Revalidation should be reintroduced as the process of fresh enlistment is cumbersome and involves utilization of a lot of resources thus wasting CPWD as well as contractors’ time.</p>	<p>Date: 14.07.2021 Ref: 241 /J/2021-22</p>
